Hot Tips for Sewists


LITTLE TRICKS THAT MIGHT SAVE YOUR SANITY

Store your stay tapes, double-sided tape, wonder tape, etc. in a zip lock bag and keep it sealed.

 Our dry climate not only sucks the life out of our skin (and thread), it also shortens the life of these expensive notions!

Use **kids washable markers** instead of tracing paper. They wash out easily.

Own a good reference book on sewing. The Reader's Digest New Complete Guide to Sewing is a great book to have on hand when you are looking for the right way to do something.

OUT OF HAND QUILTING AND FABRICS

It's like finding a treasure! This store is filled with everything that sewists, crafters and quilters could ever want including quilting and garment fabric, notions, patterns, books, kits and more.

Jut of Hand QUILTING & FABRICS

Located in the Lakeview shopping area, the store has been around for 25 years. But it's really been since 2021 when Jamie Trinier, former oil and gas engineer purchased the store, that it has become an important hub for crafters and sewists. She is also the cofounder of SewTites magnetic sewing pins which you'll find in store.

Garment sewists will be impressed with the carefully curated selection of fabric from denim and linen to silks, satin, velvet and lace to outerwear material. Crafters will find bag making hardware, a variety of wool crafting and embroidery supplies, embellishments and kits.

They also host very popular in-store classes. Four times a year, Canada's best known sewing teacher, Ron Collins, teaches Pattern Alternation, Ultimate Fitting & Sewing and a class on Quilted Sneakers. Other classes include bag making, beginner sewing and quilting.
